Memorandum of Understanding

Concluded on 30.01.2018, between following parties:

1. **Center for Sustainable Development ALKA**, with head office based at "Bul. Partizanski Odredi" Nr. 62 1/16, 1000 Skopje, Macedonia, represented by Elizabeta Gjorgjievska, President;

and

2. **Agency for Promotion and Support of Tourism in RM**, with head office based at st."Debarca" Nr. 2, 1000 Skopje, Macedonia, represented by Aleksandar Donev, Manager;

This MoU is in accordance with the objectives of the forthcoming EU funded project "Backing Regional Tourism Potential" that is planned to be supported as part of the Cross- Border Cooperation Programme Kosovo * - former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia under IPA II 2014 and 2015 allocations. The project will be implemented by Center for Sustainable Development ALKA, as Lead Partner and partner organisations, Alpine Association Marimangat, Peja, ABAT Balkania / Balkan Association for Alternative Tourism, Skopje and Mountaineers Association SHARRI – Prizren.

The project, through its various activities such as identification, marking and sign posting of routes / trails, production and distribution of promotional materials and other activities is planning to support the development of tourism in the CB region. Among other, the project will also launch a web page that aims to promote the region, that will include maps of routes / trails, various attractions, and other services that will be provided to the tourists.

Through this memorandum of understanding, which is signed between Center for Sustainable Development ALKA and the Agency for promotion and support of tourism in R.M, parties agree that:

- during the last phase of the project implementation, Agency for Promotion and Support of Tourism in RM, will take over the management of the web page jointly with the Tourist info centre in Prizren and will continue to manage it and make use of it also after the project has ended;
- they will deepen the inter-cooperation in the future, in similar actions, additionally defined when and if necessary.

The Memorandum is not a binding document and does not produce an obligation of inter-funding between involved organizations/institutions.

The Memorandum is valid until the project and post-project activities are completed.

This Memorandum enters into force on the day of its signing.
